Bill Analysis

SB 813 requires the peace officer making a preliminary investigation for an emergency protective order to make every attempt to serve the subject of the order and complete a return of service when filing the petition with the district court. The peace officer shall file the petition with the district court the next business day if the officer cannot obtain service. The measure also requires the court clerk to document the date and time for the hearing and provide such information to the officer. The officer shall also provide the victim and subject of the order with a copy of the completed order. The measure also repeals a statute relating to a Stalking Warning Letter required to be provided to a person accused of stalking.
