## **Bill Analysis**

SB 862 prohibits the government and its employees from requiring residents to receive a shot or vaccine, requiring residents to wear a mask or medical device, restricting medical treatment based on vaccination status, compelling residents to show any documentation of vaccination status, imposing restrictions that are not codified into law, restricting the rights of residents to exercise free speech or free assembly, restricting Second Amendment rights, or restricting travel. The measure subjects any official or government employee of violating these provisions to a maximum term of imprisonment of 5 years and/or a maximum fine of \$50,000.00. Such persons shall also be subject to termination or removal from office, a \$10,000.00 fine, and personal assumption of liability.
