Bill Analysis

SB 887 directs the Department of Corrections to establish a 5-year pilot program designated as the Secure Pre-Integration Pilot Program. The program shall provide re-integration assistance to offenders incarcerated for non-violent offenses. The measure requires the program to address a comprehensive plan to release an inmate to his or her family, church, or community non-profit. The family or community entity responsible for such released inmate shall monitor the person and make regular reports to the Department of Corrections. The measure also creates the Secure Pre-Integration Pilot Program Revolving Fund and authorizes the Department to retain 5% of the fund for the fund's administration.
