**Bill Analysis**

SB 896 directs the Secretary of State to develop a schedule for the initial expiration of administrative rules categorized by agency. The schedule shall be subject to the approval of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and the Administrative Rules Committee chairs of both chambers. All rules promulgated after the effective date shall expire over a 5-year period as outlined in the Secretary's schedule. The measure provides that 20% of agency rules shall expire on a 5-year basis. Each rule may be renewed for an additional 5 years by the Legislature. Agencies may request such a renewal. The measure directs the Secretary to provide notice to the promulgating agency at least 18 months prior to every rule's termination date.
