Bill Analysis

SB 913 directs the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, subject to receipt of federal funding, to provide emergency opioid antagonists to boards of education of public school districts and to develop an opioid overdose education program for school personnel authorized to administer such antagonists. The measure makes such training mandatory for authorized school school personnel and requires schools, subject to the receipt of emergency opioid antagonists from the Department, to provide authorized school personnel with emergency opioid antagonists in the event of an overdose.
