**Bill Analysis**

SB 93 provides that a microgrid owner shall not construct or maintain electric lines in or around any road, street, or public way unless certain conditions are met. The owner must provide the Corporation Commission a performance bond equal to the amount of the value of the line. The bond must be enforceable for 1 year from the date the line is energized. Additionally, the owner must notify the transmission and distribution utility providers who operate the service territory where the line is proposed to be built. If an objection is filed by the utility provider of a proposed microgrid, the Commission shall authorize the construction of the microgrid if the Commission finds that the line is not duplicative of existing transmission and distribution lines and does not interfere with the delivery of electricity to any consumers.
