Bill Analysis

SB 935 creates the Citizen Access to County Facilities Act. The measure provides that a county shall not be liable for injury to or death of a participant resulting from the inherent risks of an activity using county facilities provided the county posts the warning outlined in the measure. The measure provides that the county shall be liable if it commits an act or omission that constitutes willful or wanton disregard for the safety of the participant or has actual knowledge or reasonably should have known of a dangerous condition present at county facilities. The measure provides that the right of state residents to use county facilities shall not be abridged.
