Bill Analysis

SB 945 establishes a misdemeanor for any person convicted of depriving any animal in captivity of necessary food, drink, shelter, or veterinary care. Persons convicted of this misdemeanor shall be subject to a maximum fine of \$1,000.00 and/or a term of imprisonment not to exceed 1 year. The measure establishes a felony for any person convicted of willfully harming or killing an animal or pet in his or her care. Such persons shall be subject to a maximum fine of \$7,000.00 and/or a term of imprisonment not to exceed 10 years.
