Bill Analysis

SB 96 prohibits any person or entity from failing to disclose that a product is cell-cultured meat or is an insect-protein food product. Cell-cultured meat is defined as a food product developed from animal cell cultures rather than through traditional raising and slaughtering of livestock. Insect-protein food products are defined as food products having one or more sensory attributes that resemble a type of tissue originating from an agricultural food animal but that, in lieu of being derived from meat processing, are derived from manufacturing insect parts.
