**Bill Analysis**

SB 988 provides that the Oklahoma County Clerk instead of the Secretary of State may promulgate rules and practices governing the central filing system relating to farm products. The Clerk shall consult with filing offices in other jurisdictions and the International Association of Commercial Administrators. The measure directs the Clerk to also consider the rules and practices of, and the technology used by other offices. The measure provides that there shall be no priority among filings. Current active filings shall be filed with the Oklahoma County Clerk.
