**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB1462 directs the courts in all criminal prosecutions and juvenile proceedings to prioritize orders of payments of restitution to victims until the office of the district attorney certifies that the restitution is paid in full. The Administrative Office of the Courts(AOC) believes this will have a significant impact on revenue collections to the State Judicial Fund. While the AOC is currently working with the District Attorneys Council and district attorneys to determine the impact of prioritizing restitution payments, they are unable to provide a cost estimate at this time. The AOC believes implementing these provisions would halt or significantly hinder collections.
