ANALYSIS: Engrossed HB 2096 reauthorizes the income tax refund checkoff for the Oklahoma Wildlife Diversity Program beginning with tax year 2026. This reauthorization is necessary because the checkoff was set to expire in 2025 under 68 O.S. § 2368.18, which mandates that all income tax checkoffs in state statute expire four years after enactment unless reauthorized by the Legislature. While checkoffs can be removed under 68 O.S. § 2368.2 if total contributions fall below \$15,000 for three consecutive years, the Oklahoma Wildlife Diversity Program has consistently exceeded this threshold over the past three years.
