## Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

This bill prohibits school districts beginning August 1, 2026, from employing a special education administrator unless he or she has a standard teaching certificate and obtains acknowledgement of competency within one year of being employed in the position. It provides guidelines for the State Board of Education to issue acknowledgements of competency. It requires a special education administrator to complete the subject area competency examination in mild-moderate disabilities, severe-profound disabilities, or comprehensive special education. It exempts from the acknowledgement of competency requirement those who have a master's degree in certain areas.
