Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 1074 requires any person holding wildlife or domesticated animals hunted for sport for a commercial harvesting facility to first procure a license from the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, and requires such facilities to be issued a commercial harvesting facility license upon completion of an application and adherence to all applicable laws and rules.

The Department states they would need one additional veterinarian at \$142,200 for salary and benefits, \$95,023 in salary and benefits for two livestock inspectors, and a one-time impact of \$100,00 for two vehicles for the inspectors. Their total impact is estimated at \$432,250 for FY'26.
