**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 109 requires any health benefit plan including the Oklahoma Employees Insurance Plan to provide clinical genetic testing for certain markers relating to cancer and evidence-based cancer imaging for individuals with increased cancer risk.

HealthChoice currently covers clinical genetic testing for an inherited gene mutation and evidence-based cancer imaging for individuals with an increased risk of cancer. However, the plan does apply member cost share where appropriate. Actuarial analysis estimates the fiscal impact to be approximately \$150,000 based on current utilization, which they deem negligible considering the overall total claims spend.
