Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

This bill extends the time period for eligible students to participate in OHLAP to no later than December 31 of their 12th grade year or prior to reaching the age of 17. It allows the Regents to provide an exception to the age limits provided for and prohibits a student 21 or older to participate.

The provisions of this legislation will likely increase the scholarships awarded to eligible students. Given the timing of the OHLAP award and enrollment cycle, the FY 26 potential increase in scholarship demand should be limited and will likely be covered by reserve funds.
