**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 153 requires a person who is voting to sign an oath attesting that the address listed is his or her address. Any person who cannot sign the oath shall be given a provisional ballot when allowed by law. The precinct official shall provide such a voter with a change of voter registration form to update the address. The Election Board estimates training, development, and testing for the program to cost \$20,000. Additionally, the Board estimates an additional \$780,000 will be needed per statewide election for increased staffing needs to implement the provisions of the measure.
