**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 158CS creates the Oklahoma Emergency Weather Response and Tracking Regulatory Act. It allows a qualified media outlet or qualified institution of higher education to hire up to five professional severe weather trackers, and if they do so, requires specific identification, driving courses, insurance, etc. to maintain their status and grants the trackers with specific driving related authorizations in the event of a significant weather event.
