**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

This bill directs OEQA to establish a grant program to provide individuals issued emergency or provisional certificates to teach with grants to assist them in obtaining alternative placement teaching certificates. It directs grants to be awarded annually to up to 1,000 applicants on a first come, first served basis. This bill is subject to availability of funding with a cap of \$2 million.

The Office of Educational Quality and Accountability has estimated the annual cost of the program to average \$2,613,816, broken down as follows:

- Program Manager - \$33,800
- Program Specialist - \$52,000
- Legal support - \$17,340
- Program Evaluation - \$5000
- IT Grant Tracking - \$5000
- Grant Disbursement - \$2,500,000
