**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

This bill modifies the minimum salary schedule for certified school personnel. It clarifies that if a district receives Foundation Aid or Salary Incentive Aid or receives neither, the State Department of Education will allocate funds provided for the financial support of public schools to such districts in order to implement the teacher salary increase that went into effect in 2023-2024 school year.

The State Department of Education is unable to calculate a cost until after the Midyear School Personnel Report is collected on February 3, 2025.
