**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 197 authorizes the Legislature to call a special election for initiative petitions. If the Legislature and Governor set conflicting dates, the special election shall be held on the second Tuesday of November in an odd-numbered year, or the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November in an even-numbered year. The Oklahoma State Election Board notes a special state question election would have an estimated fiscal impact of \$2,100,000. However, the Board states that if the election coincided with an existing statewide election, the only additional fiscal impact would be the possible need for additional ballot pages.
