Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 199 authorizes the court determining guardianship of a proposed ward with a neurological condition such as Alzheimer's disease, dementia, or other similar developmental disability to compel the applicant for guardianship to complete prerequisite training. The measure directs the court to require such persons to complete an attestation or verification of completion of prerequisite training specific to the needs of the ward or to waive such requirements. The list of approved training programs shall be maintained by the Department of Human Services. The Department does not anticipate any negative fiscal impact.
