Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

This bill creates the Oklahoma Math Achievement and Proficiency Act.

2 FTE at OSDE to oversee reporting and data related to the bill: \$180,000/annually

15 person instructional team established within a 3 year pilot program to serve sites around the state: \$2,000,000/annually

15 coaches to travel to schools around the state: \$300,000/annually

Professional learning for math instructional team: \$750/person, 15 coaches, \$15,000/annually

Professional learning for teachers including materials and instructor: \$500/teacher; 1,000 teachers; \$500,000/annually.

Math screeners will need to be established. The state or districts will be responsible for the associated costs. This estimated cost is provided based on the prior cost for a K-5 literacy screener. \$3,000,000/annually.

Office supplies, technology, printing, shipping, books, and resources: \$50,000/annually. Fiscal Impact provided by the State Department of Education.
