Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 216 provides that any person who has been convicted of an offense that does not require the mandatory revocation of his or her driver's license and whose license has expired while in the custody of the Department of Corrections may enter into an agreement with Service Oklahoma for a provisional license. Payment of outstanding fines and fees shall not be required in the 6-month provisional license period. At the end of the period, the licensee shall pay a \$25.00 minimum fee per month to satisfy outstanding fees and fines. The Department of Corrections estimates 60 days and \$15,000 in additional labor hours will be needed to expand the existing licensing program to meet these provisions.
