Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 263 expands the Terry Peach Water Restoration Act by adding the redberry and ashe juniper trees and the honey mesquite to the list of harmful woody species.

The Conservation Commission estimates a \$1,000,000 to outfit and hire 3 cedar technicians, \$1,000,000 for cost sharing with recognized governmental entities or non-profit organizations, and \$500,000 for grants for prescribe burn associations and rural fire departments. Therefore, the Commission expects a fiscal impact of \$2,500,000.
