**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 264 directs the Corporation Commission to coordinate with the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) and Oklahoma One-Call System to establish a GIS-based web service application that supports public work projects, utility planning, and infrastructure coordination.

The Corporation Commission estimates a reoccurring annual cost of \$448,672 for 2 FTE GIS analysts to receive data and process information for the GIS platform. They expect a one-time cost of \$95,251 for application development by an outside entity and rulemaking for promulgating new rules.
