Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 272 creates a subcategory of a distiller license, providing that any distiller producing 2,500 cases or less in the last calendar year shall pay an annual fee of \$320.00, and that any distiller producing more than 2,500 cases in the last calendar year pay an annual fee of \$3,125.00.

The ABLE Commission would have to employ software code writers to create a new license for the subcategory, which may cost between \$20,000 and \$30,000. There are currently 16 licensed distillers in the state, and if the same number of distillers would for the lower license price, the fiscal impact would be a revenue decrease of \$44,880 in the first year. As the proposal does not go into effect, that fiscal impact would become \$29,866.67. Therefore, the total fiscal impact for FY'26 is between \$49,867 and \$59,867.
