**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

The committee substitute for SB275 creates the Oklahoma Workforce Housing Commission (OWHC) to serve as the primary coordinating body for addressing the needs of workers at all income levels by advancing suitable housing to facilitate community economic growth. The proposal directs the Oklahoma Workforce Commission (OWC) to promulgate rules relating to housing reports and needs assessments for affordable workforce housing and development.

The Oklahoma Workforce Commission estimates a fiscal impact of approximately \$100,000 to add housing data subsets to the planned workforce data system and increase the scope of work and create additional application programming interfaces. The Commission also anticipates an additional impact of \$75,000 in costs aside from any salary requirements if OWC is assigned deliverables for the referenced study and report.
