## Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 3 defines sludge and biosolid material and establishes a moratorium on sludge and biosolid and material until July 1, 2028. The bill directs the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to revoke all current active permits.

The Department has 54 permitted land application sites for septage haulers. The annual permit fee for these sites is \$353.19 a year. The DEQ estimates a fiscal impact of approximately \$19,072 annually.
