**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 316 directs Service Oklahoma to develop a voter identification card that includes a photograph of the person to whom the card is issued. The measure provides that beginning January 1, 2026 each voter shall be required to present a photo ID that satisfies all requirements of “proof of identity”. The measure also provides that the voter ID developed by Service Oklahoma shall be provided free of charge. Service Oklahoma is unable to determine the amount of the voting population that would request and/or need the voter identification card, as many of the photo IDs registered voters already possess would meet the requirements of this measure. Though, the agency notes that the printing cost per credential would be \$2.00, and the cost would be dependent on the amount of cards issued.
