## Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 329 provides that a person may apply for an absentee ballot by signing the ballot and attaching a valid photo ID in lieu of having his or her signature notarized by a notary public. The measure also provides that a person who applied for a ballot in this manner shall be provided the opportunity to cure a defective application. The Oklahoma State Election Board estimates a cost of \$40,000 for printing new absentee materials and training of election officials.
