**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 33 authorizes the Office of the State Treasurer to issue a transaction card to citizens of Oklahoma with the ability to make purchases that are debited from the balance of deposits with a bullion depository created by the Office of the State Treasurer or contracted with other public or private entities operating a bullion depository.

The bill has no impact as it authorizes an action but does not require any action to be taken. The Office of the State Treasurer is not able to provide a Fiscal Impact if the agency were to act upon the newly acquired authority. Processing, monitoring, and auditing the transactions would likely require additional staff.
