**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB332 modifies the fee for a medical marijuana dispensary license to a flat fee of \$4,500.00.

SB332 would increase the annual license fee by at least \$500 a year for 1,600 dispensaries and decrease the annual license fee by at least \$500 a year for 131 dispensaries. Assuming the number of dispensaries in the state remain the same and remain in the same tier (anticipating similar sales compared to the previous year), the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) estimates an increase of \$1,887,900 to license fee collections in the first year. SB332 would also require changes to OMMA's licensing system, which would come at a nominal cost.
