Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 35 increases the minimum wage to \$15.00 an hour.

The Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) estimates a fiscal impact of \$2,214,209.71 for the first year. This figure was calculated by using state employee workforce data from January 1, 2025. The FTE of each worker was part of the calculation as not all are full-time workers. This does not include national guard, board members, contractors, or state employees of the Grand River Dam Authority. The FY'26 Impact is the impact from the effective date of the proposal to June 30, 2026.
