**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

This bill modifies the Lindsey Nicole Henry Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program. It modifies eligibility to remove the requirement that the student attend a public school district the year prior to applying for the program.

OSDE is unable to determine the number of students who may become eligible for the scholarship.

Cost is determined by using FY 25 initial state aid factor of \$4,195.41 and grade level weight and disability weights, if applicable.

Estimated cost below is calculated based on a grade level weight range of 1.0 to 1.5; a disability category weight range of .05 (SLI) to 3.8 (VI) disability category weight. Cost will vary with changes in grade level and if additional disability factors are added.

Per student is projected to range from \$4,196 to \$22,236, further adjusted by the actual cost of tuition and the allowable administrative fee of 2.5% of the scholarship amount.
