## Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 380 would direct the state to display a monument of the Ten Commandments both within and outside the State Capitol as a symbol of its historic significance. The measure directs the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor to meet within 1 year of the effective date to determine the design, placement, security, and funding of the monument. The measure allows for the Pro Tempore, Speaker, and Governor to consult with third-party groups to assist in making such determinations. Only donated funds shall be used to design, place, and secure the monument. Any person who knowingly damages the monument shall be guilty of a felony. No state funds shall be used for the project; therefore, no fiscal impact is expected.
