**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB465 exempts institutions of higher education from the annual limit on charitable alcoholic beverage event and charitable auction licenses.

Institutions of higher education are currently allowed to conduct 8 charitable events and 4 auctions per year on the license. If enacted, SB465 would allow institutions to conduct 4 more events and would no longer have to pay for another \$55 license. The Commission states they currently have 60 charitable event licenses issued to colleges and universities and if allowed to conduct 4 more events under this license, they would lose approximately \$3,795 in revenue.
