**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 550 prohibits any person from engaging in an adult cabaret performance which is harmful to minors or to organize or authorize the viewing of an adult cabaret performance on public property or in a location where the adult cabaret performance could be viewed by a minor. Violators shall be guilty of a felony and subject to a fine of \$5,000.00-\$20,000.00 and/or a term of imprisonment of 1-5 years within the Department of Corrections. Any person found to organize a story hour for minors that is hosted by a drag performer shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of \$500.00-\$1,000.00 and/or a term of imprisonment in a county jail not to exceed 1 year. The Department of Corrections is unable to determine the fiscal impact of the provisions, as the amount would be dependent on the number of convictions. However, the Department does note the marginal/incremental cost per inmate added to the Corrections system is \$21.26 per day or \$7,759.90 per year. Any additional revenues generated from fines would also be dependent on the number of convictions.
