**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 578 extends the sunset date of the Oklahoma Quality Events Incentive Act by 5 years, to June 30, 2031. The Act offers reimbursements to local governments up to \$250,000 on quality event expenses using incremental state sales tax revenues generated as a result of hosting or assisting in the presentation of a quality event.

As written, the proposal does not create a fiscal impact.
