**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 595 would create the Oklahoma Jail Standards Act. The measure would require all detention facilities and lockup facilities shall operate in compliance with the provisions of the measure. The measure states and describes the standards to which all detention facilities shall operate under. The measure outlines exceptions and states that all detention facilities not exempt shall be inspected at least once a year by the Department of Health to ensure compliance with the provisions set forth in the Oklahoma Jail Standards Act. The Department believes these provisions and responsibilities can be absorbed and will not require additional funds or staff.
