**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 600 would increase the court assessment provided to the Oklahoma court-appointed special advocates (OCASA) from \$5.00 to \$10.00. Per the Administrative Office of the Courts, the average amount collected from these assessments over the last 5 fiscal years was \$1,205,319, therefore the agency projects the revenue to increase by such amount.
