Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 693 would require social media platforms to display a prominent warning to any user who accesses the platform for the first time and to any established user once per day. The warning shall appear for 60 seconds and render the application unusable for that duration. The provisions of this measure shall not apply to a text messaging platform or a platform for which the primary purpose is related to education or health care. The Attorney General would be authorized to bring civil action against any social media platform in violation of these provisions. The Office of the Attorney General estimates a need for one additional attorney and one additional support staff FTE to implement and enforce these provisions.

Fiscal Impact provided by the Office of the Attorney General
