**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 713 requires owners or operators of new wind energy facilities to apply to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for installation of a light-mitigating technology system that complies with FAA regulations and requires the owner or operator to install the system within 24 months of receipt of approval. The Corporation Commission is directed to enforce the provisions of the proposal and allows them to promulgate rules

If enacted, the Public Utilities Division (PUD) will need to initiate rulemaking and hire additional staff, estimated at a recurring annual cost of \$100,000 and a one-time cost of \$50,000.
