## Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

This bill extends from 26 to 30 the oldest age an individual can be to be given the opportunity to complete high school. It states that, beginning in the 2025-26 school year, individuals between the ages of 21 and 30 shall only be eligible to complete high school if they attend a full-time virtual education program. It also excludes such individuals from being included in the calculation of a school's A-F report card.
