Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 786 would increase the fine for transporting intoxicating beverages outside of the original package from \$100.00 to \$250.00 and prohibits any person from consuming medical marijuana while operating a motor vehicle on a public highway. The measure prohibits consuming medical marijuana with secondhand smoke while operating a motor vehicle. The Oklahoma State Department of Health is unable to determine the exact amount of revenues deposited into the Trama Care Assistance Revolving Fund are from this specific fine, as the fund's collections are made up of a variety of fines, fees, and taxes. The measure is not expected to have any negative fiscal impact, though there is a possibility of increased revenues to the fund.
