**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 852 creates the Oklahoma State Guard and Militia Revitalization Act of 2025. Requires the Adjutant General to authorize at least 4 voluntary Multiple Unit Training Assemblies of Inactive Duty for Training per month and 15 days of annual training.

The Military Department anticipates a minimum impact of \$10,000,000 in the first fiscal year of implementation of the bill, with the impact as high as \$96,635,000 with the establishment of 77 units of 50 personnel to drill each month as well as perform 15 days of annual training and providing salaries, supplies, and equipment.
