**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 871 would impose a minimum sentence of 6 months imprisonment for any person convicted of eluding a peace officer. The measure increases the minimum punishment of time of imprisonment within the Department of Corrections for such a violation that endangers any other person and results in a felony conviction from 1 year to 30 months. Individuals convicted of eluding an officer and causing an accident resulting in great bodily injury to any other person shall be guilty of a felony and receive an increased minimum sentence. The minimum time of imprisonment within the Department of Corrections is increased from 1 year to 5 years and the maximum sentence is increased from 5 years to 7 years. Based on current sentencing data, the Department does not anticipate a fiscal impact.
