**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 91 creates the Spring Creek Watershed Study Act, directing the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to work in coordination with local, state, and federal agencies and non-government organizations to study the quality of water of the Spring Creek Watershed located in Cherokee, Delaware, and Mayes counties.

The Conservation Commission believes that the fiscal impact will be estimated at a cost of \$50,000.
