## Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 922 prohibits the keeping of more than five chanticleers per acre on a single property and the keeping of more than a total of 25 chanticleers on a single property, unless authorized by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry. The proposal also states the measure does not apply to public or private schools receiving state funding, 4-H or FFA programs that provide proof of program membership and county authorization, and sets a fine for violation of Section 1. The proposal directs the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to promulgate rules to enforce the provisions of the section.

The committee substitute creates no fiscal impact on the state.
