**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 93 prohibits a microgrid owner from constructing or maintaining electric lines in or around any road, street, or public way unless certain conditions are met, and with authorization from the Oklahoma Corporation Commission.

The committee substitute adds definitions not previously included in the introduced version of the proposal. The fiscal impact has not changed from the previous version of the bill.

The Corporation Commission estimates that in the event of an objection, the Public Utility Division will need to hire additional staff and/or outside experts to review the construction of the electric line since PUD does not have any in-house staff with construction expertise. Additionally, PUD will be required to conduct rulemaking. For the hiring of a consultant, additional staff, and an attorney, the Commission estimates a recurring annual cost of \$400,000 and a one-time cost of \$50,000.
